#### 10 Point Assignments:

**Computer Words:** Type your words on the computer. Change the font or color for each word. **Syllables:** Write the word. Then draw a line between each syllable.

**Upper and Lower:** Write each spelling word. Then write the word again using lower case letters for vowels (A, E,

I, O, U) and uppercase letters for consonants. Example: teacher TeAchEr

#### 20 Point Assignments:

**Rainbow Words:** Write each word in pencil. Then trace each word 3 times using a different colored pen, pencil or crayon each time.

**Questions:** Write a question that uses the spelling word for the answer. You can only use the question What is \_\_\_\_\_? one time.

**Practice Test:** Have a parent, sibling or friend call out the words to you. Check the words and write each incorrect word 5 times each. \*\*Must be signed by the person giving the test.

**Word Search:** Make a word search of all your spelling words using graph paper. You may make a word search and print it out using the puzzle maker on the following website: http://www.puzzle-maker.com/

**Criss-cross Words:** Write two words that have a common letter so they crisscross. Example: if your spelling words are alligator and because
